- RCA connector inserts are available in orange (PCM Audio), red (Right Audio), white (Left Audio) and yellow (Video). The connector housing is available in ivory, white, almond, grey and black, to match housing or wallplates.

INSTALLATION NOTES

- Secure connectors to cable prior to snapping into faceplate or surface mount housing.
- Keep digital signal bundles separate from analog signal bundles.
- Connector supports connectivity for up to two pairs. Use both pairs to reduce wire losses in longer cable runs.





